

# Batteries & Used Motor Oil/Filters

## FREE Pickup Service for Household Batteries

Place batteries in a clear and sealed bag (such as a Ziploc), and place the bag on top of the recycling cart on your recycle collection day.



### Household Batteries Include:

- Dry Cell
- Alkaline
- Rechargeable
- Lithium\*

**\*Any batteries labeled as lithium batteries MUST be taped at both ends in order to prevent a fire/explosion.**

## FREE Pickup Service for Motor Oil and Oil Filters

### To dispose of used motor oil and oil filters:

- Drain oil filters 24 hours before bagging. One (1) filter per bag
- Place motor oil and filters in containers provided by Republic Services or use a clear, plastic milk or water jug
- Tape lid to close it securely if you are using your own container for oil
- Place oil filters in a sealable plastic bag (Ziploc or oil filter bag from Republic Services)
- Wipe excess oil off bag and seal
- Place jugs and/or filters at the curb next to your recycle cart (maximum of three (3) gallons of oil per pickup)
- If recycling used oil and filters, hang the filter bag on the oil container using the precut hole at the top of the bag provided by Republic Services
- Republic Services will leave replacement bags and containers
